

In 2016, we opened our doors with just 14 beds for men.

By the end of that year, we had grown almost threefold to 40 beds.

Fast forward three years later, and not only has the men's program grown to serve 60, but we also opened our women's center for 20 ladies to build a new way of life.

With the expansions of 2019, we were able to provide services to over 80 men and women, which in turn affected the lives of over 160 children.






