DEAR SUPPORTERS.

IN THE PAST FEW YEARS, ACCEPTANCE RECOVERY CENTER HAS NOT ONLY THRIVED BUT ALSO EMBARKED ON AN INSPIRING JOURNEY OF TRANSFORMATION. OUR COMMITMENT TO EMPOWERMENT, COMPASSION, AND EVIDENCE-BASED SERVICES HAS HAD A PROFOUND IMPACT ON THE LIVES WE TOUCH, AND WE CONTINUE TO EXPAND OUR REACH AND MISSION.

IN 2020, WE IMPLEMENTED OUR ALUMNI CARE TRANSITION PROGRAM, A SIGNIFICANT STEP IN SUPPORTING OUR RESIDENTS BEYOND THEIR TIME WITH US. WHAT STARTED UNINTENTIONALLY AS SERVING FAMILIES IN OUR RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM TURNED INTO A POWERFUL ADDITION TO OUR SERVICES. WE FOUND THAT BY FOCUSING ON FAMILY PRESERVATION, WE CAN MAKE A SUBSTANTIAL IMPACT, REUNITING FAMILIES AND CREATING A SOLID FOUNDATION FOR HEALTHIER LIVES.

2021 MARKED A YEAR OF MONUMENTAL CHANGE AS WE SUCCESSFULLY TRANSITIONED FROM RENTING TO OWNING OUR LOCATION. THIS TRANSITION SIGNIFIED A NEW ERA FOR ACCEPTANCE RECOVERY CENTER, ALLOWING US TO HAVE GREATER STABILITY AND RESOURCES TO CONTINUE OUR LIFE-CHANGING WORK.

IN 2022, OUR COMMITMENT TO INNOVATION AND INCLUSIVITY REACHED NEW HEIGHTS.
