Eligibility:

- Proof of HIV Status
- Proof of income
- Proof of residency in Barrow, Clarke, Elbert, Greene, Jackson, Madison, Morgan, Oconee, Oglethorpe or Walton County
- Photo ID

Fees: based on your current income and health insurance status (Medicare and Medicaid are accepted)

Services:

- Complete annual physical exam/assessment + doctor visit
- On-site lab work for HIV care and disease stages every 3 months + review of lab results
- TB skin testing
- Hepatitis A & B immunizations, flu and pneumonia vaccines
- Chronic care + sick visits
- Evaluation and treatment for acute care conditions, such as: sinusitis, urinary tract infection, diarrhea and primary care medication dispensation
